Accommodation Your guesthouse accommodation at Aurora Retreat is located in a small village, well off the beaten tourist track and surrounded by expansive forests, pristine lakes and mighty rivers. By December, the landscape is covered with white untouched snow. The winter light can be breathtaking and the Northern Lights often appear at this time of year.

The guesthouse is a timber building dating from the 1920's which has been renovated with environmentally sustainable living in mind. There are six simple, yet elegant and comfortable, double rooms. There is a dining hall and group gathering rooms as well as quiet corners for reflection and relaxation. The guesthouse provides a calm and peaceful atmosphere and fits in well with the surrounding nature and community.

Cuisine Meals and snacks are freshly prepared with the highest quality, organic, and local ingredients available. Root vegetables, grains and pulses form the basis of most meals.
