Accommodation

The retreat guesthouse is located in a small village, surrounded by expansive forests, pristine lakes and mighty, untouched rivers. The guesthouse is a timber building dating from the 1920's which has been renovated with environmentally sustainable living in mind. There are six simple, yet pleasant and comfortable, double rooms with private or shared bathrooms. There is a dining hall, a spacious group gathering room with a fireplace, and quiet corners for reflection and relaxation. It's possible to rent the entire house for your private use or to rent just one of the bedrooms. The guesthouse provides a calm and peaceful atmosphere and fits in well with the surrounding nature and community.

Cuisine

Meals and snacks are freshly prepared with the highest quality, organic and local ingredients available. Root vegetables, grains and pulses form the basis of most meals. Occasionally, we offer local wild meat or fish. We happily accommodate those with special diets with creatively prepared, fresh food.

Example Itinerary

Price for this itinerary: 9955 SEK/adult, 5700 SEK/child under 13

Accommodation, meals, transfer from arrival city in Lapland (Kiruna, Gällivare), activities specified on itinerary below and all outdoor clothing and equipment for activities are included in price

- Day 1** **Transfer** from airport or train station in Kiruna or Gällivare to Aurora Retreat. Welcome supper. Outdoor clothing outfitting
- Day 2** Daytime: **Dog sledge tour 2-3 h.** With your partner, drive your own team of dogs over frozen wetlands and through snow-laden forests. Snack by a campfire during the tour
- Day 3** Afternoon: **Overnight Wilderness Excursion 24 h.** Transfer by sledge pulled by snowmobile to our scenic wilderness camp, where you will be accommodated in rustic cabins without electricity or running water. Your guide will help fire the sauna and make sure you are comfortable for the night. With luck, the Northern Lights will dance over the night sky.
- Day 4** Morning: Awake at the wilderness camp. Your guide returns and leads you in your choice of **tobogganing, ice-fishing, cross-country skiing or snowshoeing.** In the afternoon return to Aurora Retreat.
- Day 5** Daytime: **Visit with a Sámi reindeer herder 4-5 h.** Meet reindeer, learn about the Sámi way of life and try your hand at some traditional Sámi skills. Lunch in a traditional Sámi hut
- Day 6** **Transfer** to departure airport or train station in Kiruna or Gällivare
